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| CLINIC SPACE, EQUIPMENT, AND SUPPLIES | | |

PURPOSE: Sufficient and suitable space, equipment and supplies are available on each facility for the maintenance of an adequate health care delivery system in the prison.

POLICY:

- I. Examination and treatment rooms for medical, dental and mental health care are large enough to accommodate the necessary healthcare equipment, fixtures, and electronic equipment and to permit privacy for the offenders.
- II. Pharmaceuticals, medical supplies and mobile emergency equipment are available.
- III. Adequate office space exists for administrative files, secure storage of health records, desks, computers, keyboards, and printers to facilitate the use of the EHR.
- IV. Private interviewing space, desk(s), chairs and lockable file space are available for the provision of mental health services.
- V. If laboratory, radiological, inpatient or specialty services are provided on site, the area(s) devoted to any of these services is appropriately constructed and sufficient to hold equipment and records and for the provision of the services themselves.
- VI. A waiting area is provided with seats, drinking water and access to toilets for offenders during sick call.
- VII. Equipment will be maintained according to manufacturers instructions unless otherwise specified by written policy.
