III. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

A. Education, Experience, and Training

1. Graduation from an accredited senior high school or equivalent or GED.
2. Three years full-time, wage-earning structural pest control experience.
3. Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license.
4. Must possess a Certified Commercial or Noncommercial Applicator License issued by the Texas Structural Pest Control Service.

Must possess or be able to obtain a Certified Commercial or Noncommercial Applicator License in Termite Control and Lawn and Ornamental categories issued by the Texas Structural Pest Control Service within one year of employment date.

Selected applicants without required license(s) must sign a *Credential Contingency Agreement* that will remain in effect only until the initially established expiration date. Failure to comply with this contingency statement will result in separation from employment. *Credential Contingency Agreements* will not be extended or renewed as a result of an employee's separation from employment or acceptance of another position.

Must maintain valid license(s) for continued employment in position.

B. Knowledge and Skills

1. Knowledge of the principles, practices, and procedures of structural pest control.
2. Knowledge of state and federal laws, rules, regulations, and statutes related to the use of pesticides and equipment in structural pest control.
3. Knowledge of agency and departmental organizational structure, policies, procedures, rules, and regulations preferred.
4. Skill to communicate ideas and instructions clearly and concisely.
5. Skill to coordinate with other staff, departments, officials, agencies, organizations, and the public.
6. Skill to interpret and apply rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.

7. Skill to prepare and maintain accurate records, files, and reports.
8. Skill to plan, coordinate, and implement pest control procedures.
9. Skill to maintain an audit an inventory of pest control chemicals, supplies, and equipment.
10. Skill to train and supervise offenders.

IV. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS WITH OR WITHOUT REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION

- A. Ability to walk, stand, sit, kneel, push, stoop, crawl, reach above the shoulder, grasp, pull, bend repeatedly, climb stairs and ladders, identify colors, hear with aid, see, write, count, read, speak, analyze, alphabetize, lift and carry 45 lbs and over, perceive depth, operate a motor vehicle, and operate motor equipment.
- B. Conditions include working inside and outside, working around machines with moving parts and moving objects, working around moving objects or vehicles, working closely with others, working alone, working protracted or irregular hours, excessive heat, cold, dampness and chill, excessive or intermittent noise, pesticides, dust, fumes, smoke, gases, slippery uneven walking surfaces, working on ladders or scaffolding, working below ground, and traveling by car, van, bus, and airplane.
- C. Equipment (machines, tools, devices) used in performing only the essential functions include computer and related equipment, typewriter, calculator, copier, fax machine, telephone, hand held spray tanks, aerosol spray cans, motorized spray equipment, and automobile.
