



# Attorney, Family, and Victim Parole Interviews with Board Members and Parole Commissioners

Due to the growing concern over COVID-19, and to take the necessary precautions to minimize the potential to be exposed to or spread this virus, the following steps will be implemented concerning parole interviews with Board Members and Parole Commissioners. This is effective March 17, 2020.

All offender family/support interviews will be conducted telephonically.

All Attorney interviews will be conducted telephonically.

Statutory Victims are encouraged to participate in interviews telephonically. However, pursuant to statutory requirement, they may elect to participate in an in-person interview. In the event an in-person interview is requested, a screening questionnaire must be completed and approval granted prior to appearing before the Board. Contact can be made with the respective Board Office to participate in the screening questionnaire.
