National Correctional Officers' Week begins May 4

The 2014 National Correctional Officers' Week will take place May 4 through 10. This year marks the 30th anniversary of the event and the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) will hold recognition celebrations and memorial services in honor of the dedicated men and women who have accepted the responsibility and met the challenge of preserving public safety.

In addition to the events scheduled at individual units and offices throughout the agency, TDCJ will also hold a Fallen Officers' Memorial Ceremony in remembrance of those who lost their lives in the line of duty. This year's ceremony is scheduled for Thursday, May 8, and will be held on the grounds of the



Texas Prison Museum in Huntsville. Executive Director Brad Livingston will be among the scheduled speakers at the service, scheduled to begin at 10:30 a.m. Coverage of the Memorial Ceremony will be included in the next issue of Connections.
