QUALITY IMPROVEMENT/QUALITY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM		

PURPOSE: To establish and maintain a program of ongoing quality management activities consistent with standards determined by a nationally recognized correctional accrediting agency, and with other policies, regulatory authorities and applicable laws.

POLICY:

- I. The Correctional Managed Health Care Committee, its agents, and the TDCJ Health Services Division will establish and maintain a comprehensive Quality Improvement/Quality Management Program (QI/QM). QI/QM Program implementation at the facility and regional/divisional levels will be in accordance with the QI/QM Procedures Manual.
- II. The oversight of the QI/QM Program is the responsibility of the Office of Health Services Monitoring. This responsibility includes ensuring that copies of the Quality Improvement/Management Procedure/Program Manual and its revisions are distributed to each facility annually.
- III. The final authority and ultimate responsibility for a comprehensive and integrated QI/QM Program shall rest with the Correctional Managed Health Care Committee and the TDCJ Division Director for Health Services.
