TOBACCO FREE ENVIRONMENT		

PURPOSE: To establish employee and inmate tobacco use guidelines within the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) in accordance with Board Rule 151.25 dated October 7, 2007.

POLICY:

- I. All inmates and persons visiting inmates are prohibited from possessing or using any tobacco products.
- II. Employees are permitted to use tobacco products in designated areas of the parking lots, designated areas adjacent to the parking lots or in personal vehicles.
- III. Human Resources representatives are responsible for maintaining the approved list of designated areas and posting the list on the employee bulletin board.
- IV. Employees will not use tobacco products while in contact with inmates or clients regardless of location.
- V. No tobacco products may be utilized as reinforcers (rewards) for acceptable behavior in any health care program.
- VI. Violation of this policy may result in disciplinary action or loss of privileges as applicable.
