The Following Instructions Will Help You Take the Best Care of Your Eye Glasses

Prescription eye glasses may be replaced every twenty-four (24) months as needed. Eye glasses will be replaced earlier if determined by an optometrist or ophthalmologist to be necessary. Documented loss, broken eye glasses with no evidence of self-destruction, or newly diagnosed surgical conditions will be considered exceptions.

TDCJ documented confiscation of glasses will be considered for replacement.

When showering, consider leaving your glasses in your house to eliminate danger of loss, damage, or theft.

Plastic lenses scratch easily. Therefore, run water over the lenses before using a soft, cotton cloth to dry them.

A sick call should be submitted for broken prescription glasses. Repair attempts will be made.

If there is a problem after two (2) weeks with a new prescription, you should submit a sick call – give specific information regarding your problem.

Bring your glasses and case with you for any related appointments.
