

2026 Silver Policy (Previously Select)— Summary of Benefit Changes

This document highlights **only the benefits of Participating Attorneys that are changing** in the Silver (previously Select) Policy for the 2026 coverage year. A full 2026 Silver Policy will be issued separately.

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Benefits with New 3-Month Waiting Periods (Effective 2026)

Important Note: Waiting periods do not apply to renewing members in good standing. Waiting periods are also waived for first-year members who enroll in an annual membership.
