Introduction

The Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) Fiscal Year 2024 Statistical Report provides demographic information for a total of 612,652 cases under supervision on August 31, 2024, as well as those received and released throughout the fiscal year. An inmate may have multiple types of supervision and be counted in more than one of the categories provided. The report includes information for both the incarcerated inmate population and the adult population that is supervised in the community.

The **Demographic Highlights** section offers a summary of the characteristics of the incarcerated population that was on hand as of August 31, 2024, and inmates who were received and released during the fiscal year. The characteristics include gender, average age, race, offense, custody, sentence length, and educational achievement measures. This section also includes characteristics of inmates who were under the jurisdiction of the Parole Division and Community Justice Assistance Division.

The **On Hand** section of the report provides an in-depth look at the incarcerated population on August 31, 2024. In addition to comprehensive demographics, this section focuses on the offense, sentence length, and release eligibility of the inmates. Detailed information is provided for the prison, state jail, and Substance Abuse Felony Punishment (SAFP) populations.

The **Receives and Admissions** section includes demographics of inmates who were received by the TDCJ during the fiscal year. Inmates who are received are categorized as New Receives, Parole and Mandatory Supervision Revocations, Parole Out of State Receives for Revocation Processing, and Community Supervision Direct Sentences or Modifications. New receives are inmates who are admitted to the TDCJ who are not under the supervision of the Parole Division. This category also includes inmates who are under the supervision of local Community Supervision and Corrections Departments who have not served in the TDCJ for that offense. Parole and Mandatory Supervision Revocations include inmates who were revoked from parole supervision. Parole Receives for Revocation Processing include inmates being supervised out of state who are returned to the TDCJ and then considered for revocation. Community Supervision modifications include those inmates under the supervision of local Community Supervision and Corrections Departments who are being incarcerated due to unsuccessfully completing the terms of their supervision after being released from the TDCJ on that offense. In addition to demographics, this section also includes offense of record, county of conviction, and sentence information. As a separate category, admissions to the TDCJ include inmates who returned from bench warrant from prior fiscal years and transfers from other TDCJ divisions.

The **Releases and Departures** section provides demographics of inmates who were released from TDCJ custody during the fiscal year. Inmates who were released are categorized as Discharges, Releases to Community Supervision, and Releases to Parole Supervision. Discharges are inmates who are released from the TDCJ either by full expiration of their sentence or by court order. Releases to Community Supervision are inmates who are released to be supervised by local Community Supervisions and Corrections Departments. Releases to Parole Supervision include releases to parole, mandatory supervision, and discretionary

mandatory supervision. These types of releases are under the jurisdiction of the Parole Division. As a separate category, departures from the TDCJ include deaths, executions, transfers between TDCJ divisions, and bench warrant releases that did not return during the fiscal year.

The **Intermediate Sanction Facility (ISF)** section of the report provides an in-depth look at the on hand population on August 31, 2024. In addition to comprehensive demographics, this section focuses on the offense and county of conviction. Detailed information is provided for the community supervision and parole supervision populations.

Statistical tables listing categories by county of conviction (i.e., On Hand, Total Receives and Releases by county) have the 30 counties with the highest population in the state according to census population highlighted in **bold**.

An offense is classified as a drug offense if federally designated as a drug offense (NCIC codes begin in 35); as a property offense if federally designated as property (NCIC codes begin in 36-42, 48-63, or 70-73); or as another offense if federally designated as other (NCIC codes begin 14, 36, or higher than 36) unless the offense is designated as violent.

An offense is classified as violent if federally designated as violent (NCIC codes beginning in 09, 10, 11, 12, 13, or 16); statutorily designated as violent (Article 42A.054, Code of Criminal Procedure); the inmate directly caused or threatened to cause serious bodily harm or death to another individual unless the act was an accident; the inmate forced another party to act in an involuntary manner by use of threats or intimidation or some other form of pressure or force; or the inmate traffics another person with the intent that the trafficked person will engage in forced labor or services.

Glossary of Terms

"3G" Offense – The offenses listed in Article 42A.054 (formerly listed in 42.12, Section 3G) of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure. Examples of "3G" offenses are murder, capital murder, indecency with a child, aggravated kidnapping, aggravated sexual assault, aggravated robbery, use of a child in the commission of certain drug offenses under the Health & Safety Code, committing certain drug offenses within a drug-free zone (if it is shown that the defendant has been previously convicted of certain drug offenses for which punishment was enhanced pursuant to the Health & Safety Code), sexual assault, use of a deadly weapon, and any offense with an affirmative weapon finding.

Security Detention – A non-punitive, maximum custody status involving the separation of an inmate from general population, used for an inmate who is a current escape risk; threat to the physical safety of other inmates or staff, to include volunteers and contract employees; threat to the order and security of the prison as evidenced by repetitive serious disciplinary violations; or a confirmed member of specific security threat groups (STG).

Admissions – Bench warrant returns from prior fiscal years and transfers among the agency.

Community Supervision – Placement of an inmate under supervision for a specified length of time, as ordered by a court, with court-imposed rules and conditions. Community supervision (formerly called adult probation) may be ordered for misdemeanor or felony offenses and is generally imposed in lieu of a jail or prison sentence.

County of Conviction – The county that correlates with the offense of record.

Departures – Deaths, transfers among the agency, and bench warrant releases that did not return during the fiscal year.

Direct Supervision – Inmates who are legally on community supervision and who work or reside in the jurisdiction in which they are being supervised and receive a minimum of one face-to-face contact with a Community Supervision Officer (CSO) every three months. Direct supervision begins at the time of initial face-to-face contact with an eligible CSO.

Discharge Releases – Prison inmates who are released from TDCJ either by full expiration of their sentence or by court order.

Discretionary Mandatory Supervision (DMS) – A type of release from prison provided by law for restricted categories of inmates. Inmates with offenses committed on or after September 1, 1996, who are released from prison under Mandatory Supervision contingent upon approval by a Board of Pardons and Paroles panel vote (see Mandatory Supervision).

G/J1 – 3 and OT – Inmates in these custodies have a good disciplinary history; have served a specified portion of their sentence (varies by custody level); and do not have any security precaution designators. Some levels within these custodies (G1/J1/OT) do not allow current or prior convictions for intentional homicide and sexual offenses, or any pattern of freeworld violence. Inmates in programs that require G1-G2 or OT custody prior to enrollment are included in this category.

G/J4 – Inmates in this custody have two or more non-assaultive disciplinary convictions resulting in major penalties within the past six months; one disciplinary conviction resulting in a major penalty for inmate or staff assault without a weapon within the past 12 months; Line Class II or III time-earning status (prison inmates only) if the inmate is not assaultive or aggressive in nature; or placement of a security precaution designator for escape (ES), staff assault (SA), or hostage (HS).

G/J5 – Inmates in this custody have one or more disciplinary convictions for an assault with a weapon on staff or inmates within the past 24 months; two or more disciplinary convictions resulting in a major penalty for inmate or staff assault without a weapon within the past 12 months; one or more disciplinary convictions resulting in major penalties for extortion or sexual abuse with the past 24 months; primarily Line Class I, II, or III time-earning status (prison inmates only) if the inmate is assaultive or aggressive in nature; or escaped from a TDCJ secure adult correctional facility within the past five years.

Residential Reentry Center – A residential facility with focus on reintegration of inmates back into the community after a period of incarceration.

Indirect Supervision – Level of community supervision that requires the inmate to report in person but does not require face-to-face contact.

Intelligence Quotient Score (IQ) – The individual's score obtained from a group-administered IQ test. For treatment purposes, additional tests are used to identify mentally impaired inmates.

Intermediate Sanction Facilities (ISF) – A secure facility used as an alternative to incarceration for individuals who violate the conditions of their community supervision, parole, or mandatory supervision, but whose supervision was not revoked. ISFs are utilized by Community Supervision and Corrections Departments (CSCD) for individuals on community supervision and by the Parole Division (PD) for those on mandatory supervision inmates. Incarceration is generally 60 to 90 days and may include cognitive or substance abuse treatment.

Mandatory Supervision (MS) – A type of release from prison provided by law for restricted categories of inmates. Eligible inmates are released on MS when their calendar time served added to their good time credit equals the length of their prison sentence. Under the law in effect until August 31, 1996, release to mandatory supervision was automatic for most inmates, with no requirement of release approval from the Board of Pardons and Paroles. Inmates who committed their offense after August 31, 1996, must receive approval from the Board of Pardons and Parole.

New Receives – Inmates admitted to a TDCJ facility for the first time on an offense or are repeat inmates who were not under parole or mandatory supervision at the time of their new conviction.

Offense of Record – The offense for which an inmate is incarcerated. If an inmate is incarcerated for multiple offenses, the offense of record is the offense that requires the inmate to be incarcerated for the longest period of time.

Parole – The conditional release of an inmate from prison, by a Board of Pardons and Paroles decision, to serve the remainder of his or her sentence under supervision in the community.

Parole-in-Absentia (PIA) – Inmates released to parole or mandatory supervision from either county jails, out of state facilities, or in federal penal institutions.

Parole/DMS/MS Revocations – Inmates returned to TDCJ for a violation of parole or mandatory supervision. Revocations can be for a new offense or for technical reasons.

- **New Offense** – Violation of supervision by the conviction of or pending charges of felony or misdemeanor offenses and possible technical violations.
- **Technical** – Violation of one or more conditions of release, not including commission of a new offense.

Parole Out of State Receives for Revocation Processing – Inmates being supervised out of state who are returned to the TDCJ and then considered for revocation. Revocations can be for a new offense or for technical reasons.

- **New Offense** – Violation of supervision by the conviction of or pending charges of felony or misdemeanor offenses and possible technical violations.
- **Technical** – Violation of one or more conditions of release, not including commission of a new offense.

Prison Inmates – Inmates with capital, first, second, or third-degree felony convictions.

Receives – Inmates arriving at TDCJ during the fiscal year as a new inmate or for revocation processing.

Releases – Inmates leaving TDCJ due to the discharge of their sentence or to another form of supervision.

Releases to Parole Supervision – Includes releases via parole, discretionary mandatory supervision, and mandatory supervision.

Safekeeping – Inmates who require separate housing for reasons that include, but are not limited to, vulnerability, threats to their safety, and potential for victimization.

State Jail Inmates – Inmates convicted of state jail felony offenses. An individual adjudged guilty of a state jail felony offense may be confined in a state jail facility for a term of no more than two years or less than 30 days. There is no parole or mandatory supervision release from state jail; however, a judge can grant early release under certain circumstances to include diligent participation in inmate programs.

Substance Abuse Felony Punishment Facility (SAFPF or SAFP) Inmates – Inmates who are sentenced by a judge as a condition of community supervision or sent by the Board of Pardons and Paroles as a modification of parole supervision to an intensive six-month therapeutic community program (nine-month program for inmates with special needs).

Endnotes

- ¹ Average sentence length for SAFP inmates is based on program length. The current program is six months for regular needs and nine months for special needs.
- ² Inmates in programs that require G1-G2 or OT custody prior to enrollment are included in this category.
- ³ Only Prison and State Jail are included in calculation of average sentence length, time served, and percent of sentence served. Sentences > 60 years including Life sentences are calculated as 60 years for the purpose of calculating an average sentence length. Death Row and Life Without Parole inmates are not included.
- ⁴ Certain admissions are not included in this table. Admissions are bench warrant returns from prior fiscal years and transfers among the agency.
- ⁵ If an inmates's custody was not assigned before the end of the month of the date received, the custody as of August 31, 2024, or the custody upon release if the inmate was no longer incarcerated, was used.
- ⁶ Certain departures are not included in this table. Departures are deaths, executions, transfers among the agency, and bench warrant releases that did not return during the fiscal year.
- ⁷ Percent of sentence served is calculated using a case-based methodology.
- ⁸ This population are those inmates who are sentenced to community supervision through the local and district courts (excludes municipal, state, appellate, and specialty courts).
- ⁹ The On Hand Total does not include inmates temporarily out on bench warrant.
- ¹⁰ State Jail inmates received for homicide are convicted of criminally negligent homicide; those received for indecency with a child are convicted of exposure; and those received for violent sexual offenses are convicted of civil rights violation of a person in custody.
