**Batterer Intervention and Prevention Program (BIPP) Grant Funding Methodology**

**New BIPP Grant Requests**

Programs that are fully accredited, consistently report program information, and have been non-profit status for five or more years were prioritized for potential new grant funding.

**Continued BIPP Grant Requests**

Four scoring elements were used to determine program funding. Each element's percentage of the total program score was determined in collaboration with the Texas Council on Family Violence. The four scoring elements included:

1. Two most recent program audit scores;
2. Successful completion rates;
3. Program monthly data report submissions; and
4. Program quarterly financial report submissions.

Each program's total score was compared to the statewide benchmark. Results were applied as follows:

- Below benchmark = 10% reduction;
- At benchmark = funded at FY '18-19 level;
- Above benchmark = 10% increase not to exceed requested amount.
