One-Time Grant Funding

One-time grant funding is awarded on a competitive basis. A solicitation email, with the request form attached, will be sent to the CSCDs from CJAD for requests to be submitted. If a request for funds is not initially awarded, the funding request will remain active for the duration of the fiscal year in which the request was submitted in the event additional funds become available. The priorities for distribution are determined biennially.

Methodology

One-time grant funding request scores are determined by the following elements:

1. Supports treatment programs and direct treatment services;
2. Impact of funding on core functions of the CSCD; and,
3. CSCD's level of financial need.

Additional considerations:

- Prior one-time funding within same fiscal year;
- Regional or multi-CSCD funding request;
- Interfund transfers to Diversion and/or TAIP Programs;
- Status of action plans related to DP/TAIP programs;
- Reductions in funding and impact of the recommendations on each department as a whole; and,
- Inventory of requested items as compared to similar size CSCDs, if applicable.
