

Clinical Documentation

- 3 CEH** This class/training offers an overview of the required documentation standards and expectations. This includes but is not limited to clinical file requirements, narrative notes, treatment plans, treatment plan reviews, continuum of care plan, discharge plan, etc. Review of all policies and procedures associated with clinical documentation.

Clinical Supervision

- 3 CEH** This training provides a review of clinical supervision, the difference in supervision and training, styles and content of supervision meetings, assessment and evaluation in clinical supervision, and problems in clinical supervision.

Cognitive Intervention

- 2 CEH** Focus is placed on the Addiction/Offender Cycle, Thinking Report, and introduction to the Self-Control model to change criminal thinking and patterns of repeated substance use. The participants will learn skills that will assist the client to reentry and integrate into society.

Correctional Awareness

- 4 CEH** This class explores why and how inmates manipulate counseling staff. It offers solutions to how staff can protect themselves from manipulation and keep themselves out of ethical and disciplinary quandaries.

EEO/PREA

- 2 CEH** Staff will watch the TDCJ required videos and have group lead discussion.

**** Participants must watch the TDCJ PREA video, which is not attached to the lesson.**

Ethics & The Law

- 3 CEH** This class/training focuses on applicable laws & agency policies of conduct relating to Client Rights, Neglect & Exploitation; types of abuse and neglect w/ agency policies for reporting. Covers confidentiality, extending boundaries, multiculturalism and diversity, the use of technology, record keeping, the selection of interventions, and preventing the imposition of counselor personal values..

Group Therapy and Peer Groups

- 3 CEH** Participants will learn the differences in group counselling style which will assist them in facilitating the curriculum and engage the clients in the group process. Principles of Motivational Interviewing Techniques to facilitate client awareness and change.

HIV/Hepatitis C and Sexually Transmitted Diseases

- 6 CEH** This class/training offers participants a didactic overview on the difference between HIV and AIDS, how HIV is transmitted, as well as, identifying the methods of prevention. It also looks at how substance use is directly related to HIV infections. Offers participants a didactic overview on common sexually transmitted diseases (STD's), how they are transmitted, the trends (both in the United States and Texas), treatment options, as well as the consequences to the four causes of transmission.

Intake, Screening, & Assessments

- 4 CEH** Review program policies and intake procedures. Review screening and assessment tools, including ASI and effective measurement of client care. Include DSM 5 criteria and review for assessment and diagnosis.

Motivational Interviewing

- 2 CEH** This class offers an in depth look at the principles, techniques, strategies, and overall spirit used with Motivational Interviewing. Allows participants the opportunity to practice the skills that will help elicit behavior change in their clients as well as explore and resolve their ambivalence through intrinsic motivation.

Non-Violent Crisis Intervention

- 4 CEH** This class helps the counselor appropriately identify an inmate/individual in crisis and the steps involved to help the inmate/individual function at a pre-crisis level. Participants also address the ethical responsibilities of reporting incidents where inmates pose an immediate risk to themselves or others.

Policies and Procedures

- 2 CEH** Participants will review and discuss relevant policies and procedures.

Relapse Prevention

- 3 CEH** To learn skills to address relapse prevention and how to develop a plan to maintain positive changes in behavior relating to recovery w/ emphasis on re-entry planning.

Therapeutic Community

- 16 CEH** The focus of this training will be to educate staff on how the therapeutic community operates within the criminal justice system.
