- Post-Secondary Education Reimbursement** – No upfront tuition fees; college expenses incurred by the offender *shall be repaid* by offender upon release. Upon release, if total owed cannot be paid, a monthly payment plan is established with the Parole Officer.
- Direct Pay** – Payment of tuition fees paid directly to the college or university by an outside source (e.g., family member, friend).
- I-25** – Offender payment of tuition fees with an I-25 from his/her Inmate Trust Fund.
- Hazelwood Benefits** – Available for Texas residents with an honorable discharge from their military service. Offender is required to provide copy of DD-214 for verification.

*Interest Forms submitted are valid for 3 years from date of submission, after this time period a new form must be submitted to remain active on the interest list.*
